Welcome to Kelmarsh Hall Northamptonshire

Built in 1732 to a James Gibbs design, Kelmarsh Hall is surrounded by parkland and beautiful gardens. The 110 acre event site has views across the lake to the Hall and is the perfect location for Family Fun Days, Team Building and large scale events.

Located less than a mile from Junction 2 of the A14 and 15 minutes from the M1 and M6, Kelmarsh Hall provides a peaceful and private setting with an exclusive use policy and easy access from all parts of the country.



The House

Kelmarsh Hall has a variety of rooms to meet your requirements starting with The Great Hall, which is the centrepiece of the house and is the first room to be entered through the front door. With its Italian pink walls and fine 18th century ceiling it makes the perfect reception area for greeting your guests when on cooler days the fire is lit.

Beyond the Great Hall is the Saloon, another 18th century room with fine plasterwork and polished oak floorboards. This room overlooks the ornamental lake with views stretching beyond the water across the open countryside.

The Ballroom has recently been renovated, returning this stunning room with views over and beyond the West Terrace, to a room for entertainment and entertaining.

Any combination of table and chairs can be accommodated in the Ballroom allowing up to 110 guests to attend lectures, seminars and dinners.

The newly renovated Basement area provides a smaller seminar room for up to 30 delegates or an intimate bar area for entertaining.



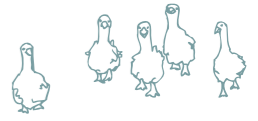
The Gardens & Beyond

Kelmarsh has an exclusive use policy and guests are encouraged to use the gardens.

Should you wish, the team at Kelmarsh are able to arrange any combination of facilities. The parkland provides space for a firework display and, for something very different, the woods and surrounding countryside provide facilities for outdoor pursuits and off road driving.

The Great Hall

- Width - 29' 6" (8.85 metres)
- Length (front door to archway) - 28' (8.40 metres)
- Height to bottom of Chandelier - 10' (3 metres)
- Corridor between Great Hall & Saloon - 9' 6" wide (2.85 metres)

Saloon

- Width (doors to windows) - 24' (7.20 metres)
- Length - 37' 4" (11.20 metres)
- Height to bottom of Chandelier - 8' 8" (2.65 metres)

Ballroom

- Width (fireplace to windows) - 25' 5" (7.60 metres)
- Length - 37' 4" (11.20 metres)
